Results: In total, 1293 refugees were included, of whom 728 were Syrians (413% females) of median age 18 years (interquartile range 7-30) Depending on the site, between 31% and 77% reported having experienced at least one violent event in Syria, 248-575% during the journey to Greece, and 5-8% in their Greek settlement Over 75%
