"Something very sad has happened" Build on information your child might already know: "You know mommy's been sick," "You know grandpa is very old" • Speak as plainly as possible "Your sister has died" Don't try to soften the news with indirect language ...

What Is a Tragedy? A tragedy is a very, very, very sad and terrible event I may first learn about a tragedy when I watch television This is because tragedies almost always happen someplace else Tragedies have survivors Survivors are people who are alive after a tragedy They have lost something very important to them, like their home

learn how to help the children in their life cope with loss something very scary and create a fantasy that is much worse than the facts you some very, very sad news Johnny's body has stopped working Johnny died" Be prepared to hold the child close and be open

How to Talk to a 14-18 Year-Old Teen about a Suicide ...

"This is something that makes me sad and I need to get some help, too (from clergy, friends, and/or my doctor)" • Reassure them that you are in charge and in control, and that they can come to you with concerns and questions
