## Ship Passenger Lists

This movement of people is called the Great Migration. The Elizabeth left Ipswich, Suffolk, England on April 10, 1634. The ship's "master" was William Andrews (Andrewes) (Andres), arriving in Massachusetts Bay. The date of record, in this case, is some six months after the ship departed. The ship arrived safe at Massachusetts Bay.
