The Dolaucothi Gold Mines, also known as the Ogofau Gold Mine, are ancient Roman surface and underground mines located in the valley of the River Cothi, near Pumsaint, Carmarthenshire, Wales. The gold mines are located within the Dolaucothi Estate which is now owned by the National Trust. They are the only mines for Welsh gold outside those of the Dolgellau gold-belt, and are a Scheduled Ancient Monument. They are also the only known Roman gold mines in Britain, although it does not exclude the

The Dolaucothi Estate, owned by the National Trust is adjacent Dolaucothi Gold Mines. It is tenant farmed but has a series of signposted scenic walks ranging for 1 - 4 hours duration. Dolaucothi is Welsh for Cothi meadows, Cothi being the beautiful River Cothi which flows through the estate. Free

parking is available in the Gold Mines car park opposite main entrance to The Dolaucothi Estate.

Dolaucothi Gold Mines sits in the heart of the Cothi Valley where gold was mined from the hills more than 2000 years ago. The mine yard sits at the bottom of one of our largest workings, a large open cast pit. The mine yard is situated above the car park with an 80m tarmacked sloped 1:7 driveway connecting the two.

The Dolaucothi Estate is situated about 1 mile north-west of the village of Caio up the picturesque Cothi Valley in the community of Cynwyl Gaeo, Carmarthenshire, Wales. Its name of Dolaucothi means 'the meadows of the Cothi'. The medieval manor house overlooking the fast-flowing River Cothi was rebuilt by the Johnes family and, in 1873, the estate encompassed 3,172 acres. Dolaucothi House could be approached by two drives of considerable length, that to the east skirting the Roman gold ...
