Mezirow (2009) offers this definition of transformative learning: "Transformative learning may be defined as learning that transforms problematic frames of reference to make them more inclusive, discriminating, reflective, open, and emotionally able to change" (p. 22, emphasis in original).

Transformation Theory: A theory of adult learning

The Transformational Learning Theory originally developed by Jack Mezirow is described as being "constructivist, an orientation which holds that the way learners interpret and reinterpret their sense experience is, central to making meaning and hence learning" (Mezirow, 1991). The theory has two basic kinds of learning: instrumental and communicative learning.

The Transformative Learning Theory: What eLearning ...

Transformative learning refers to those learning experiences that cause a shift in an individual's perspective. It is based on the idea that learning is "the process of making a new or revised interpretation of the meaning of an experience" (Mezirow, 1990). This happens when adult learners change their assumptions or expectations.

Transformative learning is in clear contrast to the more common process of assimilative learning, the type of learning that takes place when students simply acquire new information that can easily fit into their pre-existing knowledge structures.
