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### Pain Management Coding Guidelines

The ICD-10-CM Official Guidelines for Coding and Reporting provide extensive notes and instruction for coding pain (category G89). Review these guidelines in full. The following summary identifies key points. When seeking a pain diagnosis, identify as precisely as possible the pain's location and/or source. If pain is the primary symptom and you know the location, the Alphabetic Index generally will provide all the information you need.

#### Pain: ICD-10-CM Coding - AAPC Knowledge Center

Some of the most commonly used pain management billing codes include: 20610 - major joint/bursa - injection or aspiration of the pes anserine bursa, subacromial bursa, hip, trochanteric bursa, shoulder, or knee. 77002 - Fluoroscopic needle guidance (non-spinal) 20552 - Trigger point injection in one or two muscles.

Coding Guidelines Pain - Category 338 [Do not assign a code from subcategories 338.1 and 338.2 if the underlying (definitive) diagnosis is known, unless the reason for the encounter is pain control/management and not management of the underlying condition. [Note: The term "encounter" is used for all settings, including hospital admissions

#### Coding Pain Management Services - AHIMA

Code 338.3 is used to classify pain related to, associated with, or due to a tumor or cancer whether primary or secondary. This code is used as the principal code when the admission or encounter is for pain control or pain management. In this case, the underlying neoplasm should be reported in addition.

#### Coding Guidelines for Pain - AHIMA

Similar to other specialty-specific billing, pain management and anesthesia coding has its own special set of rules and guidelines. Each one of these guidelines is specially formulated to make sure the insurance company knows how the pain management service was performed, who provided the service, and how it should be reimbursed.

#### Anesthesia and Pain Management Billing Guidelines

Pulsed RF is for pain management of should pain, but isn't reimbursed by insurances. BUT, if the doctor is doing a true thermal suprascapular nerve RFA, the correct code would likely be 64640 (other peripheral nerve ablation).

#### Take the Pain out of Documentation, Coding and Billing for ...

The ICD-10-CM guidelines state that if the cause of the pain is known, you should assign a code for the underlying diagnosis, not the pain code. However, if the purpose of the encounter is to manage the pain rather than the underlying condition, then you should assign a pain code and sequence it first.

#### Reporting Pain in ICD-10-CM | Coding Strategies

Anesthesia and Pain Management Anesthesia is the administration of a drug or gas to induce partial or complete loss of consciousness. Services involving administration of anesthesia should be reported by the use of the CPT anesthesia five-digit procedure code plus modifier codes.
